



What is a PTFA?

The PTFA is a group of parents/carers, teachers and friends of Hampton Dene School who are best known for trying to raise extra funds for our children's school.

The PTFA Committee looks after the day to day running of the PTFA. This is made up of the Chairperson, Secretary & Treasurer; and most importantly 2 Class Reps from each school year.

The class reps attend the majority of PTFA Meetings and provide feedback to and from their classes to the Committee and are our main means of communication with the wider school. Their role is to “rally the troops” and coordinate volunteers, whether it’s manning stalls at the Summer Fayre or collecting bottles for the Christmas Tombola – the most important thing that they do is to encourage their classmates to support and help at events throughout the year.

Our fundraising events are great opportunities for everyone associated with Hampton Dene School to get together and have fun whilst raising money.

How money is raised

Throughout the year many different events take place, for example, school discos, Christmas & Summer fayres, cakes sales and many more.
