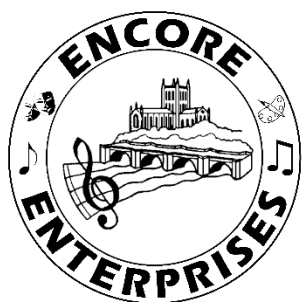




KS1 Home Learning Music Activities Summer Term - Week 12

Now make up your own 4-beat rhythm pattern using the word rhythms from the video:

Tea **Coffee** **Lemonade** **Rest**

Each word makes one beat so you need **4 words** to make your pattern. Remember a rest means you leave a 1-beat silence.

Here are some patterns for you to say, clap and play:

Tea Tea Coffee Rest

Coffee Coffee Coffee Tea

Lemonade Lemonade Tea Tea

Tea Rest Lemonade Tea

Now make up your own pattern. Try to keep a beat and try repeating your pattern. You could even put some of your rhythm patterns together with family or classmates!
